**Encrypted communication for
mere mortals
(superheroes welcome, too)**

Problem: Centralisation

- **gmail, hotmail, you name it**

Federation

- **user → provider → provider → user**
- **eg: SMTP, XMPP**

Better federation

- **The users should be protected from the provider.**
- **The provider should be protected from users.**

What does LEAP do?

1. **LEAP Platform:**
a toolkit to make it easy for you to run a service provider.
2. **New protocols:**
so that users don't need to trust the provider.
3. **Bitmask client:**
a client that works smoothly with any compatible provider.

LEAP Platform

Example: Setup 2-node VPN provider

```
sudo gem install leap_cli
leap new example --domain example.org
cd example
leap add-user --self
leap cert ca
leap cert dh
leap cert csr
leap node add blueberry services:openvpn \
    ip_address:1.1.1.1 openvpn.gateway_address:1.1.1.2
leap node add raspberry services:couchdb,webapp \
    ip_address:1.1.1.3
leap init node
leap deploy
```

New Protocols

- **Soledad:** searchable client-encrypted synchronized database.
- **Bonafide:** secure user registration, authentication, password change, etc.
- **Key management:** precise rules for OpenPGP best practices, automated.

Current Services: VPN

- Route all your internet traffic through an encrypted channel.
- Prevent eavesdropping (thieves in the public network, police, ...).
- Circumvent internet censorship.
- Prevent leaks (DNS, IPv6, ...).

Current Services: email

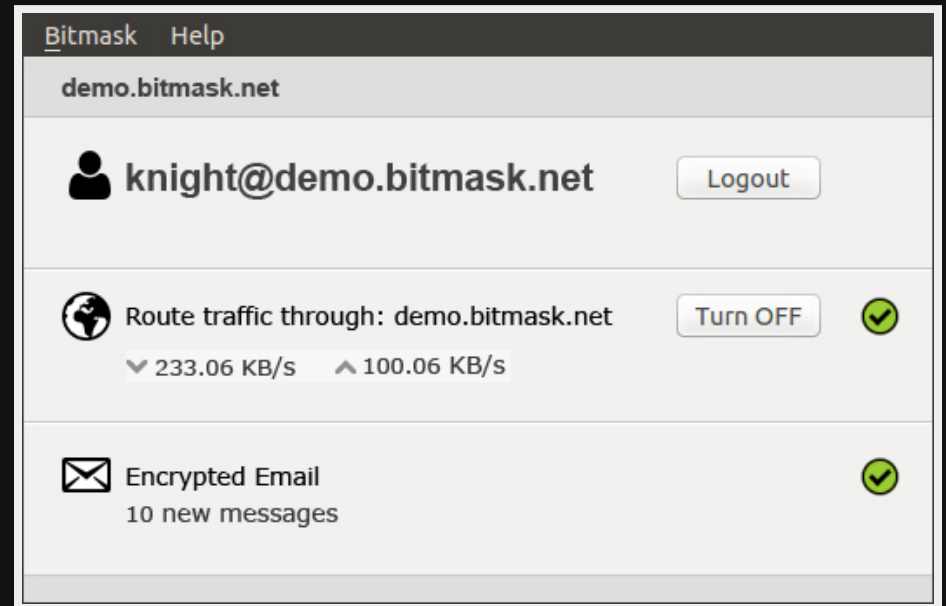
Work in progress

- End-to-end encryption using OpenPGP.
- Automatic key discovery and validation.
- Service provider has no access to user data.
- Strong protection for metadata, whenever possible.
- Cloud synchronized for high availability on multiple devices.
